About the IAUP Semi-Annual Meeting 2026

The IAUP Semi-Annual Meeting 2026 will convene 100–150 university presidents, rectors, and senior leaders from around the world to discuss the transformation of higher education in the context of sustainability, innovation, and artificial intelligence.

The program includes Executive Committee and Board of Directors meetings, keynote and plenary sessions, thematic discussions on sustainability, innovation, and AI, MoU signing opportunities, networking sessions, cultural programs, and a campus visit to Daffodil Smart City, alongside the celebration of DIU's 25th anniversary.



About the Host Institution

The event is hosted by Daffodil International University (DIU), a leading private university in Bangladesh, recognized in world university rankings such as QS and Times Higher Education (THE). DIU is ranked 221st in Asia (QS Asia 2026) and 1st in Bangladesh (THE WUR 2026), 1st in Bangladesh in both THE Impact Rankings 2025 and QS Sustainability Rankings 2026 with strong performance in research and interdisciplinary innovation.

DIU is number one private university in Bangladesh in terms of Scopus and Web of Science indexed research publications. QS World University Rankings also recognizes DIU as a "Very High Research Intensive University".

DIU hosts over 25,000 students across 7 faculties and 32 departments, including 100+ international students, offering a globally inclusive learning environment with modern facilities and strong industry connections.

The university maintains over 600 international partnerships and actively engages in student and faculty exchange, international internships, research collaboration, scholarships, and global mobility programs.

The university has also successfully hosted major international events, including the AUPF 2019 and the AUAP General Conference 2022.

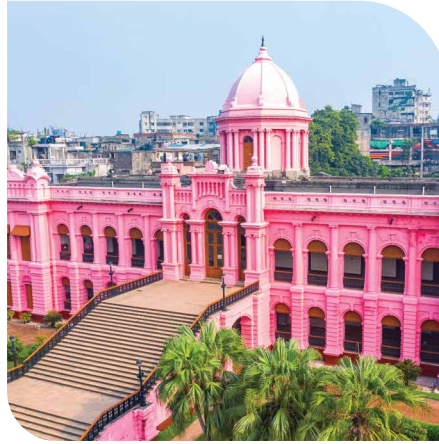
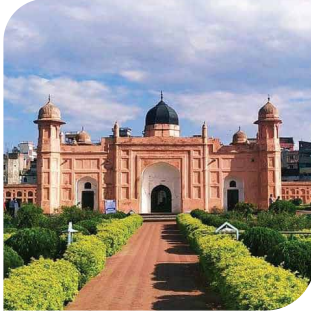

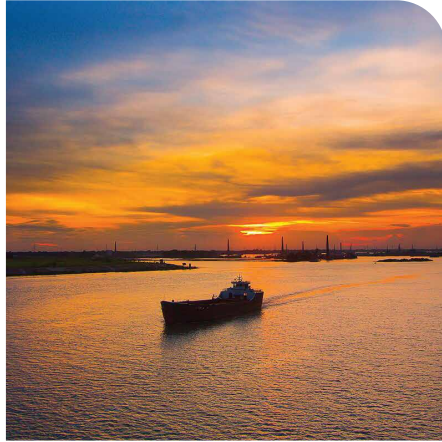

About Dhaka, Bangladesh

Dhaka is the capital city of a South Asian country, Bangladesh. It is the hub of economic, political and administrative enterprises located in central Bangladesh at 23°42'N 90°22'E, on the



eastern banks of the Buriganga River. It lies on the lower reaches of the Ganges Delta and covers a total area of 306.38 square kilometers (around 118.29 square miles). Historically, Dhaka was associated with the

periods of Kamarupa kingdom, Sena kingdom, and Sultanate period, and was a part of Mughal Empire, Nawabi Period, British. The capital has a favorable climate characterized by tropical monsoon from June to October; mild winter from October to March; hot, humid summer from March to June.

The demographic features of the city are varied in character. Dhaka city corporations are the most populated urban areas with the highest density accommodating over 22 million people including Muslims, Hindus, Christians, Buddhists and others.
